## NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Notice is hereby given that Philippine Fire and Marine Insurance Corporation, previously placed under conservatorship and receivership for cause by the Insurance Commission, is now due for liquidation. The Insurance Commission appointed Atty. Marianne P. Lozada-Marquez as Liquidator effective 13 February 2018.

Parties having claims against the company are hereby notified to file their claims under oath with the Liquidator not later than one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of the last publication of this Notice on 120 March 2018 or until 27 August 2018, together with all supporting documents detailing the character, basis and amount of each and every claim, either personally or by mail directly with the liquidator's address at LEYNES LOZADA-MARQUEZ LAW OFFICES, 15th Floor, Petron Mega Plaza, 358 Sen. Gil Puyat Avenue, 1200 Makati City, Metro Manila or the Insurance Commission, 1071 United Nations Avenue, Manila, for consideration in the company's liquidation pursuant to pertinent provisions of the Amended Insurance Code.

CLAIMS FILED AFTER 27 August 2018 SHALL BE BARRED FOREVER AND SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY MANNER WHATSOEVER IN ANY KIND OF DISPOSITION, PARTITION, DISTRIBUTION, OR SETTLEMENT IN THE LIQUIDATION PROCEEDINGS AGAINST THE ABOVE-MENTIONED INSURANCE COMPANY. HENCE ALL CLAIMANTS ARE REMINDED TO FILE THEIR CLAIMS ON TIME.
